Mark WC3W gave a presentation on the CQ DX Marathon program. The Marathon is designed to promote DXing by encouraging you to 'work the world' each year. There are 4 entry categories – limited, unlimited, formula and QRP. The website – dxmarathon.com – has been completely revamped and now includes a tool so you can chart your progress for the current year – marathon.ham2k.net. New for 2024, are the DX Marathon Challenge Award, as well as Youth and YL categories. Club entries are also encouraged. The submission process has been streamlined. No QSLs are required, you just submit your log for the calendar year. Mark reported that participation has increased 50% from 2022 to 2023.
